APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

May Regular Meeting Minutes: A motion was made by Deputy Supervisor Dunham, seconded by Councilor J. Horning to approve the May Regular Meeting Minutes as received. Roll taken...motion carried.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT:

Moment of Silence: Deputy Supervisor Dunham called for a moment of silence for Harold Petrie on his recent passing. Harold served on the Parish Planning Board for many years, and was a founding member of Tug Hill Tomorrow Land Trust.

COMMISSION REPORTS:

Community Affairs, Parks, Preservation and Recreation: Councilor G.R. Horning stated that the ground is too wet at the park to install the playground equipment at this time. As soon as the ground dries up, the Highway Department will try and install some of the equipment.

Emergency Services, Engineering, Public Safety & Water: Deputy Supervisor Dunham stated that he only has 1 person that has expressed interest in serving on the Water Committee.

Councilor Dunham stated that he is trying to set up a meeting with Miller Engineering to begin forming the Water Committee and discuss holding more informational meetings for the public.

The Building Committee has not met at this time.

Budgeting and Financial Affairs: Councilor J. Horning stated that there were questions on the Highway Budget on some budget lines that were over. Councilor J. Horning stated that due to miscalculations on budget lines, there were no overages and there is no problem with the Highway Budget at this time.

Husted Road was discussed regarding maintaining the road as it has been abandoned. There are homeowners that reside on the road. There are questions regarding legalities of maintenance of roads once they are abandoned. Attorney Genant stated that this issue was researched once before and he would review the issue again.

Mike Paternoster, Pleasant Lawn Cemetery Assoc. President asked if the Town could possibly oil and stone some roads in the cemetery.

Attorney Genant will also look into that issue.

Also, Mr. Paternoster stated that Pleasant Lawn Association aided Bidwell Cemetery with some funds for removal of trees.

Reginald Ware expressed his disagreement with Assessor Lopitz's decision on denying his STAR Exemption and his assessment on an unfinished home.

Mr. Ware expressed concerns that he feels that he is being treated unfairly and he's getting conflicting information from Albany regarding the criteria to receive the STAR Exemption. Attorney Genant will look into the issue.
