TOWN OF PARISH HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT BUILDING REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS

We are requesting proposals for engineering/architectural services for the purpose of scoping the project, help in preparing grant and/or financing applications (specifically to Rural Development for the Community Facilities program, but could also include other sources), and cost estimate documentation to support those funding requests.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The town wishes to contract for engineering and/or architectural consultant services to assist in scoping repairs needed to the highway barn, prepare cost estimates of anticipated costs and to help the town prepare for a USDA Rural Development Community Facilities program application and other grant and financing opportunities. - 1) Cursory building conditions assessment to determine general need for repairs.
- 2) Cost for new rubber roof.
- 3) Cost for replacement of structural beams.
- 4) Cost for removal and replacement of concrete floors, including drainage grating.
- 5) Possible oil and water separator upgrade.
- 6) Update heating system.
- 7) Cost of any other recommended building repairs important to the useful life of the building.

The contract will be awarded based on the consultant's knowledge, experience and approach to addressing our specific needs, along with cost of services. The town of Parish reserves the right to reject any or all responses, and to engage in simultaneous detailed discussion with two or more consulting firms.

- 1. Statement of qualifications should include three to five references of projects in similar-sized communities.
- 2. Statement of the problem as understood by the consultant and the consultant's approach to the project.
- 3. Estimate of consultant's fee.
