Town of Parish Board Workshop April 27, 2023

The Parish Town Board met at Merrill Park at 6:30 pm.

Present: Supervisor Bernys, Councilor G. R. Horning, Councilor D. Houghton, Councilor G. Wood, Sue Halbritter, Queen Central News; Todd Ingersoll, Nick Pidkaminy, Al Wert, APW Little League; Paul Baxter, Tug Hill Rep.

Excused: Councilor R. Eaton-Novak.

The Board:

- 1. Looked over and discussed the baseball fields with the reps of the Little League that were present.
- 2. Looked over and discussed the playground equipment that was presently there.
- 3. Looked over and discussed the paving and sealing of the tennis courts.

The Board ended their tour of the park at 7:20 pm.

The Board reconvened at the Parish Village Gym at 7:30 pm.

Roll Call: Sup. Bernys; Councilor G.R. Horning; Councilor D. Houghton and Councilor G. Wood.

Excused: Councilor R. Eaton-Novak.

Also Present: P. Baxter, Tug Hill Rep.

Old Business:

Merrill Park: The Board went over the bids for the paving and sealing of the tennis courts at Merrill Park. The Bo0ard received 3 bids.

- 1. Murphy Installations-\$60,500.
- 2. J & S- \$50,000.
- 3. Lightening Paving-\$52,000.

Councilor Wood made a motion to accept J & S's bid for \$50,000 and \$5,000 for sealing, which was seconded by Councilor Horning. Roll taken.... Carried.

Merrill Park Fencing Quotes: Councilor Wood made a motion to get quotes for the fencing at Merrill Park, which was seconded by Councilor Houghton. Roll taken.... Carried.

Purchase of Sand: Councilor Wood motioned to approve up to \$1,000 to purchase sand for the baseball fields at Merrill Park, seconded by Councilor Houghton. Roll taken.... Carried.

ARPA Funds: Councilor Wood made a motion to use ARPA funds for the paving, sealing and fencing at Merrill Park, which was seconded by Councilor Houghton. Roll taken.... Carried.

New Truck: Councilor Wood made a motion to purchase a new truck for the Highway Dept., for \$72,556 out of the ARPA funds, which was seconded by Supervisor Bernys. Roll taken.... Carried.

LED Conversions: Councilor Houghton made a motion to use \$8000 of ARPA funds to convert the park lights to LED, which was seconded by Councilor Wood. Roll taken.... Carried.

Committee for Playground Equipment: Councilors Houghton and Wood will be on the committee and the Board will contact CARPP, which Councilor Horning is a member of, and get their input. Some ideas are to update the frisbee golf area, get soccer goals and some BBQ grills. \$55,000 was budgeted for the playground plus there was \$21,000 left over from last year. Councilor Horning made a motion to apply \$50,000 of the ARPA funds for the playground, which was seconded by Councilor Houghton. Roll taken.... Carried.

Mini Bridge: Councilor G. Wood suggested the Board have a ini bridge put in the park over a wet spot between the playground and the baseball field.

Highway Garage Alarm Bids: The Board opened the 2 bids.

- 1. Doyle-\$6300 plus \$45 per month monitoring fee.
- 2. Fire Detection System-\$11,295 plus \$500 annual monitoring fee.

Councilor Wood made a motion to accept Doyle's bid for the Highway Garage alarm system, which was seconded by Councilor Houghton. Roll taken.... Carried.

County Mowing Agreement: The County pays the Town \$8,000 for us to mow their sections of roads in the Town. Councilor Wood made a motion to accept the County Mowing Agreement, which was seconded by Councilor Houghton. Roll taken.... Carried.

Valley Gate: Councilor Horning said he was not pleased when the County changed the name of St. Mary's Road to Valley Gate without input from the Town.

Insurance: The Board discussed the Town's insurance.

Reserves: Sup. Bernys said he is working on setting up reserves for the Town's bank accounts.

Business off the Floor: None.

Adjournment: Councilor Houghton made a motion to adjourn at 8:40 pm, which was seconded by Councilor Horning. Roll taken.... Carried.
